This year, *CBS Evening News* anchor and managing editor Katie Couric will deliver the keynote remarks, and Academy Award®-winning actress Dame Helen Mirren will receive the Sherry Lansing Leadership Award which is presented annually to a woman of unusual distinction and originality who has carved a unique career and at the same time contributed significantly to the social good. Academy Award® winner Halle Berry, who was the 2009 recipient, will present this year's award to Mirren.

The Women in Entertainment Breakfast is held annually in conjunction with the publication of *The Hollywood Reporter's* "Power 100: Women in Entertainment" special issue, which highlights the top 100 women in the motion picture, television and related industries.
